## Equipping Leaders for an AI-Driven World

As educators, we are preparing children for jobs of the future – an employment future where having skills using Artificial Intelligence technologies will be paramount. The more that school and district leaders can build their AI expertise, the better equipped they will be to make key decisions about their students' futures.

### Five Bi-Monthly Structured Collaborative Sessions

Throughout five two-hour virtual sessions, cohort members will build knowledge of how AI is being used in classrooms and districts today, learn strategies for developing cohesive AI strategies and AI policies, hear insights from thought leaders in the K-12 AI space, and stay current on K-12 AI innovations.

### One-on-One Coaching, Workshop Sessions, and Capstone Project

Cohort members will also participate in three to four hands-on workshops to build skills and to share insights and best practices. Members will also complete and present a project related to AI in the context of their school or district – all with the structured support of one-on-one coaching sessions from TNTP team members and their partners.

# Artificial Intelligence Educational Leadership Cohort

TNTP's Artificial Intelligence Educational Leadership Cohort is a year-long professional learning experience for school and district leaders who want to deepen their understanding of AI and its potential in education. Participants will build practical AI skills and learn how to develop thoughtful AI strategies for their school or district.

The cohort includes five group sessions, at least three of four workshop options, and a capstone project focused on artificial intelligence in a school or district context.
